Band Bios

Marvin King

Marvin King is a seasoned guitarist, vocalist, and songwriter whose career spans decades of live performance and recording. His musical journey began in Germany, where he started playing at just 13 years old while his father was stationed at Ramstein Air Force Base. Performing at the well-known Black Cat Lounge, King developed his early stage presence and sound in a unique international setting.

In 1980, King signed a recording contract with Polydor Records, marking his first major step into the professional recording industry. He later expanded his career into the country and rock markets, signing with Capitol Nashville in 1992.

Drawing from a wide range of influences, King developed a style rooted in blues and rock, characterized by expressive guitar work and a strong live-performance focus. Over the years, he has continued to perform and record, bringing experience, authenticity, and a deep connection to his music to every stage he steps on.

West Goewey

West Goewey is a seasoned keyboardist whose musical foundation began at an early age, starting piano at just five years old. He went on to study music at the University of South Carolina, further developing his skills in performance, composition, and arrangement.

During his college years, Goewey performed with The Early Wilds Band, gaining valuable live experience and refining his stage presence. His work as a writer and recording artist continued with Blue Condition out of Camden, South Carolina, where his songwriting led to a publishing contract in the 1970s.

Blending formal training with real-world performance and studio experience, Goewey brings a versatile and expressive keyboard style that complements the band's rock and blues-driven sound.

Joe Cash

Joe Cash has been behind the drums since he was old enough to hold a pair of his father's sticks. A versatile and expressive player, his style draws from jazz, rock, blues, and whatever the music calls for in the moment.

For 36 years, Joe has served as drummer, writer, and founding member of True Blues, one of the SC Upstate's premier blues groups. He has also performed with The Bad Popes for more than 20 years, bringing his steady groove and musical instincts to every stage.

Joe's love for live performance comes from the freedom it gives him to stretch out, lock in with the band, and respond creatively as the music unfolds.

John Brookshire

John Brookshire is a veteran bassist whose musical journey began at an early age, starting on upright bass in the fourth grade in Anderson, South Carolina. He later transitioned to bass guitar during his high school years, expanding his style and performance range.

Early in his career, Brookshire played in small "combo" groups, developing a strong foundation in swing and walking bass techniques. His versatility grew through years of performing across multiple styles, including rock influences during his college years, where he drew inspiration from bands like Cream and players in the style of Tim Bogert.

Over the years, Brookshire has built extensive live performance experience, including a long run playing wedding receptions and live events. He has shared a musical connection with Marvin King for approximately five decades and is now in his eleventh year performing with the Marvin King Revue.
